Did holiday finances cause you stress?

Christmas is an amazing time of the year, but it can also be stressful on your finances. How many of you remember a movie from the 1940's called "Christmas in July"? In this movie, a man named Jimmy is tricked into believing he's won \$25,000 in a national radio contest. He promptly goes out and blows his winnings on a shopping spree. When the truth comes out that Jimmy didn't really win, the department store owner tries to repossess all the presents Jimmy bought for his girlfriend, his mother and everyone on the block.

The movie has a happy ending - Jimmy is officially named the contest winner after all - but real life is seldom so benevolent when we overspend. Here are some steps to avoid such a predicament during the next holiday season:

Examine your finances

Craft a budget to approximate what you can afford to put away by subtracting expenses from income. It helps if you differentiate between fixed expenses such as your mortgage and rent and variable ones such as food, entertainment, etc. It also will help to review how much you spent on gifts this year. Whatever savings goal you come up with, divide it by the number of weeks you get paid to calculate how much to set aside each payday.

Setting up the account

Once you have your goal, the next step is to set up the account with SRFCU and decide how to fund it. If

you already have direct deposit from your employer, we can easily divert a specified amount from each paycheck - \$25, \$50 or whatever you decide - to this account.

Automating the process makes it easier to meet a savings goal while also "masking" the loss. You don't miss what you don't see!

You can also consider padding the account to go beyond gifts and cover holiday-related outlays such as decorations, dining out, and traveling.

Staying on track

The earlier you know what you're buying for whom, the sooner you can start monitoring prices and timing your purchases to take advantage of promotions and sales. If you see your budget is going to fall short of projected costs and you want to avoid incurring debt, we suggest you consider paring down your list or modifying the specific gifts you had planned on.
